

# Announcement Star Class Competition

in accordance with the regulations of the International Skating Union, the 'StarClass Rules and Regulations 2008/2009' and the conditions included in this announcement.

### **Registrations**

Registrations for the 'StarClass' category can be made by the club of the respective athlete, or by any other member of the International Skating Union. In all other categories, registrations can only be made by clubs affiliated to an I.S.U. member.

In the case of an unmanageable number of registrations, the organization committee and the coordination group is allowed to reduce the amount of permitted registrations. In this case the total number of skaters in all categories per club and/or the number of clubs will be limited. Principles like global representation, regional representation and first come, first serve will be applied.

### **Preliminary Registration**

By submitting the registration the participating club assures the payment of all attendance fees for each athlete, coach and teamleader. Furthermore every athlete have to exhibit entire documentation of the time trial performances. All requirements of the ISU regulations have to be fulfilled. (See below.)

## Attendance fees

For each registered and accredited person, e.g. every athlete and every coach/team leader, an attendance fee of 10 euro have to be paid to the organization committee.

## Conditions of contest

The qualifying schedule for each distance is based on the "all finals system" in each category. The "all final system" is used in order to guarantee a minimum number of races to all participants. The organization committee reserves the right to change the program due to unforeseen circumstances or reasons.

Only skaters who have attained any one of the Qualifying Times in a Mass Start Competition (Listed on a Members Calendar, ISU International Calendar and ISU events) may be entered. Proof must be supplied by submitting time, date and venue of the Event. These entries will be checked by the StarClass Coordination Group.

Only times skated within the current or the preceding season will be accepted as qualifying time. Only senior skaters or juniors who have achieved the time limit for the StarClass category have the option to participate in either the StarClass or Junior age categories. This decision can only be taken at the beginning of the season. But it is strongly recommended for Junior's to skate in their Age category.

Juniors who have not achieved the StarClass Time Limit can only skate in the category to which they, on the basis of their age belong, provided the respective time limit has been complied with.

**NOTE :**

*In the case of a large number of entries the organizers may make the following modifications in consultation with the StarClass Coordination Group.*

- *Only if all individual races can be held as scheduled and there is sufficient time available then the relay races will be held.*
- *One or more distances will not be skated according to the All Finals System but as a Knock Out System, starting with the longest distance.*
- *The Longest distance will be cancelled if the number of entries exceeds all expectations.*

**Board and logging**

The participating teams are responsible for their own subsistence and accommodation. For further information concerning reservations see the hotel informations below.

**Track**

The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30 by 60 meters, protected by padding covers on the boards. The standard lap has a distance of 111,12 meters with a curve radius of 8,50 meters. There will be 7 markers used to establish the curve. The length of the straight line is 28,85 m. The whole original track can be moved in two directions by adjusting the curve markers to preserve good ice conditions at every race. One finish line will be used for all races.

**Award of prizes**

There will be prizes for the first, second and the third place in the final results for each category - ladies and men. During the award ceremonies the skaters are pleased to wear their club or national track suits.

**Medical assistance**

A doctor and paramedical staff will be present at each competition day. The distance to the next hospital is approximately 2 kilometers.

**Medical insurance**

On behalf of its participating club, each athlete is responsible to ensure its own medical and accident insurance. A proof of each insurance will be requested by the organizing committee. For further informations see rule 119.

**Liability**

In accordance with rule 119, due to this competition the organization committee is not responsible and liable for any medical or personal injury, property loss or sustained damage.
